The Behavioural Health Foundation is now accepting resumes for a full time Youth Treatment Worker in our Male Youth Program just north of Selkirk. Shift work is required for this position but does not include overnight shifts.

The ideal candidate will be responsible for all activities as assigned by the Unit Coordinator to ensure that the basic as well as the treatment needs of the residents are met.

The incumbent will communicate matters of concern related to resident's needs, programming, the environment or staff members to the Director, provide appropriate care to residents ensuring physical and emotional needs are met, monitor medication, and maintain youth files.

Candidate should be a graduate of an accredited Community College or University with major course work in Behavioural or Social Sciences with two years experience in a residential setting or demonstrate an extraordinary ability complimented by life experience and other training that will allow the performance of duties.

Where equal qualifications exist, preference will be given to persons of Aboriginal descent.
