

Keyworker – Addiction Treatment Services

COMMENCING: As soon as possible

HOURS: 40 hours/week

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Keyworker will be responsible for assigned client care and maintaining the files of adult clients as well as the supervision of persons in the Addiction and Co-occurring Disorders Treatment Services. The incumbents will provide individual and group counselling as necessary and/or make referrals to the Director of Clinical Services, counsel and educate residents with regards to addictions using a model based on a non-disease approach along with attending and participating in weekly Team Meetings and Case Discussions.

REQUIRED AND PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- The candidate must be a graduate of an accredited Community College or University with major course work in Behavioural or Social Sciences
- Two years experience in a residential setting or demonstrate an extraordinary ability complimented by life experience and other training that will allow the performance of duties.
- Shift work is required for this position. Keyworkers typically work some evenings/weekend shifts and may be required to work overnight shifts to cover staff holidays pending availability.
- Knowledge of Aboriginal heritage, culture, spirituality, customs and language will be considered an asset.
