

Part Time Program Support Worker – Breezy Point (Women’s Program)

COMMENCING: As soon as possible

SALARY: \$13/hour – 14.50/hour

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Program Support Worker will work with treatment staff in providing support and supervision to clients. The incumbent will communicate matters of concern related to resident’s needs, programming, and the environment to the Director. The individual will also ensure that basic needs are supplied to residents and that all scheduled activities occur as planned. They will engage and assist residents in community outings.

REQUIRED AND PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grade 12 High School or equivalent is required and life or work experience in dealing with women with addiction and co-occurring mental health issues.
- Shift work is required for this position. Program Support worker typically work some evenings/weekend shifts and may be required to work overnight shifts to cover staff holidays pending availability.
- The successful candidate must possess a valid Manitoba driver’s licence and reliable transportation.
- Knowledge of Indigenous heritage, culture, spirituality, customs and language will be considered an asset.
