The Behavioural Health Foundation is accepting resumes for the position of full time, term Keyworker.

The individual will be responsible for assigned client care and maintaining the files of adult clients as well as the supervision of persons in residential addiction and co-occurring disorders treatment services. The incumbent will provide individual and group counselling, make referrals to the Clinical Therapist, educate residents with regards to addictions using a therapeutic community model and attend and participate in weekly team meetings and case discussions. Shift work is required for this position. Keyworkers primarily work evenings/weekend shifts.

Qualifications:

- The candidate must be a graduate of an accredited Community College or University with major course work in Behavioural or Social Sciences with two years experience in a residential setting or demonstrate an extraordinary ability complemented by life experience and other training that will allow the performance of duties.
- Knowledge of Indigenous heritage, culture, spirituality, customs and language will be considered an asset.
- Extensive knowledge of addiction and co-occurring mental health issues and trauma-informed practices.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.

Working Conditions:

- Must be able to work in a fast paced environment.
- Must demonstrate a strong work ethic and be reliable.
- Must adhere to confidentiality when working with sensitive information.
- Must have satisfactory Child Abuse Registry Check, Criminal Record Check and Driver's Abstract.
