Position: Keyworker - Addiction Treatment Services
One (1) Full –Time Permanent Position

The Behavioural Health Foundation is accepting resumes for the position of full time Keyworker in our Addiction Treatment Services program.

The individual will be responsible for assigned client care and maintaining the files of adult clients as well as the supervision of persons in the Addiction and Co-occurring Disorders Treatment Services. The incumbents will provide individual and group counselling as necessary and/or make referrals to the Clinical Therapist, counsel and educate residents with regards to addictions using a model based on a non-disease approach along with attending and participating in weekly Team Meetings and Case Discussions. Shift work is required for this position. Keyworkers work evenings/weekend shifts and may be required to work overnight shifts to cover staff holidays pending availability.

Qualifications:

- The candidate must be a graduate of an accredited Community College or University with major course work in Behavioural or Social Sciences with two years experience in a residential setting or demonstrate an extraordinary ability complimented by life experience and other training that will allow the performance of duties.
- Knowledge of Indigenous heritage, culture, spirituality, customs and language will be considered an asset.
- Also required is extensive knowledge of addiction and co-occurring mental health issues and trauma-informed practices.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.

Working Conditions:

- Must be able to work in a fast paced environment.
- Must demonstrate a strong work ethic and be reliable.
- Must adhere to confidentiality when working with sensitive information.
- Must have satisfactory Child Abuse Registry Check, Criminal Record Check and Driver's Abstract.
