RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- The individual will be responsible for assigned client care and maintaining the files of adult clients as well as the supervision of persons in residential addiction and co-occurring disorders treatment services.
- The incumbent will provide individual and group counseling, make referrals to the Clinical Therapist, educate residents with regards to addictions using a therapeutic community model .
- Attend and participate in weekly team meetings and case discussions.
- Shift work is required for this position.

QUALIFICATIONS (EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE):

- The candidate must be a graduate of an accredited Community College or University with major course work in Behavioral or Social Sciences with two years experience in a residential setting or demonstrate an extraordinary ability complemented by life experience and other training that will allow the performance of duties.
- Knowledge of Indigenous heritage, culture, spirituality, customs and language will be considered an asset.
- Extensive knowledge of addiction and co-occurring mental health issues and trauma-informed practices.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to problem-solve, to interpret situations accurately and to respond appropriately and responsibly.
- Must be willing to participate in required trainings.
