The Behavioural Health Foundation is accepting resumes for the position of Night Supervisor in Addiction Treatment Services Program. The incumbent will be directly responsible for the trauma-informed care and well-being of the residents and the facility during scheduled shifts.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- The candidate will guide and educate residents with regards to addictions using a model based on a non-disease approach, set limits on resident behavior and enforce same in accordance with program expectations.
- Remain alert and provide care and supervision of BHF's residents and buildings by ensuring that rounds of the entire BHF property are completed during each shift.
- Ensure a count of all males, female and children in the main building.
- Supervise resident night person ensuring he/she is performing his/her duties.

QUALIFICATIONS (EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE):

- Minimum Grade 12, with basic writing skills to facilitate the completing of documentation.
- Knowledge of Indigenous heritage, culture, spirituality, customs and language will be considered an asset.
- Extensive knowledge of addiction and co-occurring mental health issues and trauma-informed practices.
- Demonstrate ability to problem-solve, to interpret situations accurately and to respond appropriately and responsibly.
- Demonstrate an ability to work effectively with people without supervision.
- Must be willing to participate in required trainings.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Satisfactory criminal record check, including vulnerable sector search.
- Clear report from the child abuse registry.
- Continued employment is subject to maintaining legal eligibility to work in Canada.
- Valid Manitoba driver's license and current driver's abstract.
- Must be able to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Must demonstrate a strong work ethic and be reliable.
- Must adhere to confidentiality when working with sensitive information.
